TAKE PART IN OUR COMPETITION!

Step 1: record yourself signing, dancing or acting...

There are three categories you can enter; singing, acting and dancing or, if you're a bit of a jack-of-all-trades, you can enter all three categories.

Singing: You'll need to provide a recording of yourself singing any song from musical theatre using a backing track.

tip The judges will be looking for strong vocal ability as well as showing off your acting skills.

Dance: You'll need to film yourself dancing in any style you like.

tip To win the judges over you'll need to show that you can tell a story through movement as well as showing off your technical ability.

Acting: You'll need to film yourself performing a monologue either from a play or something original, it's totally up to you.

tip The judges will be looking for real ability to deliver your monologue with truth and honesty.

All entries need to be no longer than 90 seconds and all videos must be uploaded to YouTube.
