SBC are offering various new training programmes along the lines of e2e. Learners must be 16-18 NEET and they will receive EMA.

Gardening/Horticulture, DIY and Work within the Community – young people will have the chance to try work tasters going horticultural work, land, growing plants and veg, selling products they have grown, fixing fences and painting walls.

Creative Sewing – working alongside 2 ladies in Stockton Business Centre who 're-work' items of clothing, equipment will be supplied as well as sewing machines, fabrics, materials, buttons etc. There will also be a cat walk clothes show in August at Stockton Cricket club that trainees will be involved in.

Catering – young people will be based at Billingham Community Centre and will work with experienced catering staff to get a work taster in catering. They will be producing food to sell to the public, so anyone interested in catering may want to try this.
