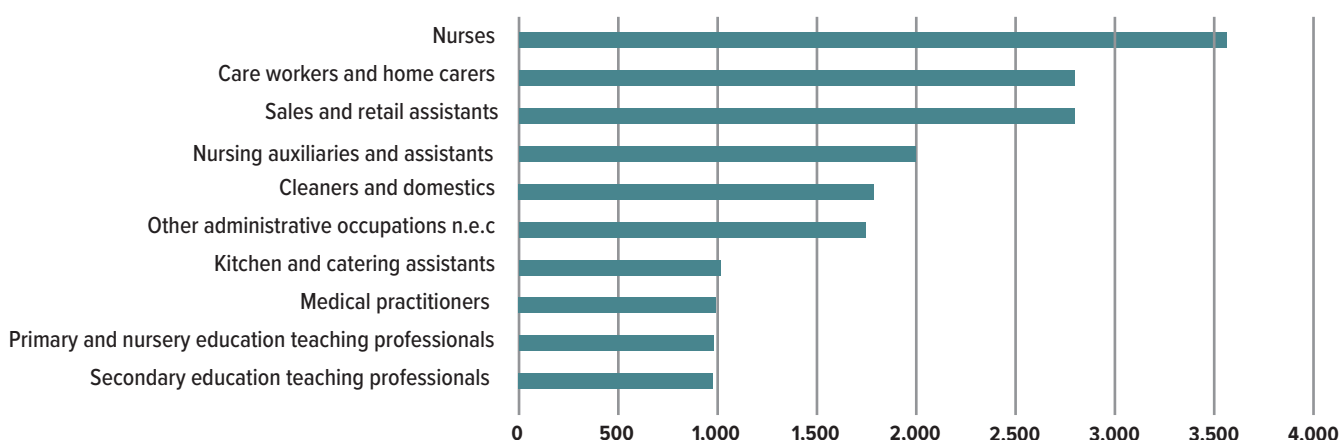

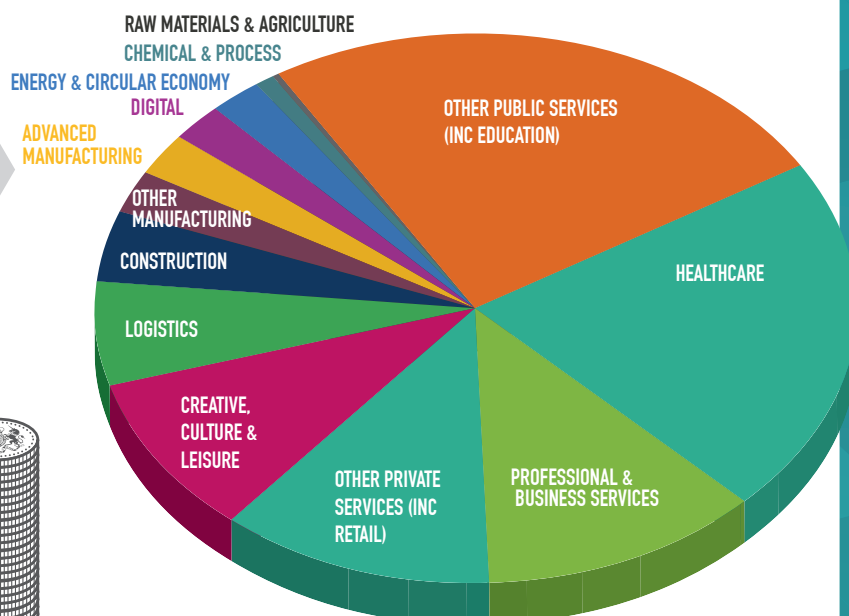

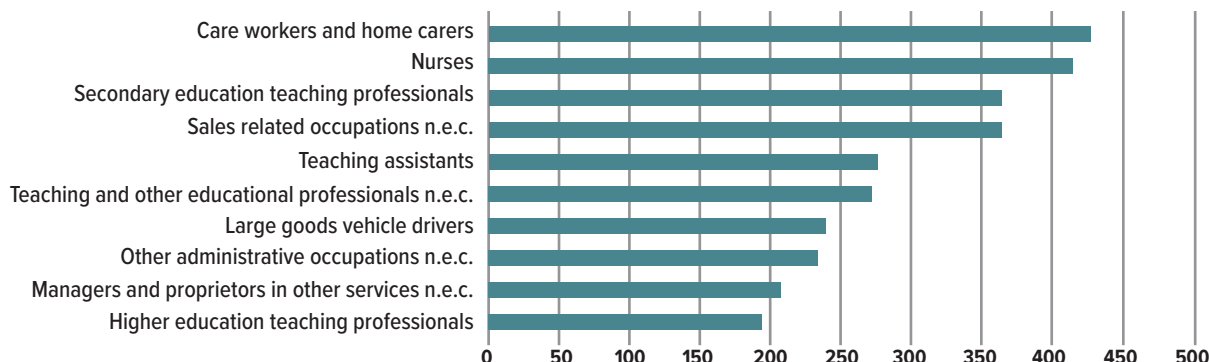
Nationally almost 30% of people employed in the Creative, Culture and Leisure sector and 25% of people in Retail are aged between 16 and 24.
