Welcome to the second issue of the Teesworks Skills Academy newsletter, giving you the latest developments from the Skills Academy and how these can translate into jobs, training courses and opportunities to get involved with Teesworks.

It is difficult to believe that the Teesworks Skills Academy has been in operation for only nine months, and in that time the team has connected with so many local people:

- More than 3,349 people have been in touch with us
- More than 1,381 have registered their CVs
- More than 407 people have benefited from training to help them access local employment opportunities
- More than 42 companies are working with us at the site and an additional 38 organisations across the region
- More than 196 people have been placed into jobs who have registered with us



Creating new skills and upskilling with the Teesworks Skills Academy

Michael, aged 33, has recently completed a number of qualifications with the Teesworks Skills Academy including; high pressure water jetting, manual handling, confined spaces, first aid and site safety passport after being recommended by a friend who had secured employment with WSG through the Teesworks Skills Academy.

These courses, which were fully funded, have given Michael the opportunity to work on the Teesworks site as an Industrial Services Technician with WSG. He is now looking at further training opportunities in the future with the Teesworks Skills Academy in the hopes of becoming a digger driver as well as progressing in the industrial services sector.

New opportunities in demolition at Thompsons of Prudhoe

Darryl (pictured left) and Phillip were out of work until they were introduced to the Teesworks Skills Academy and are now employed as Demolition Operatives at Thompsons of Prudhoe.

The new recruits completed the Routeway to Demolition course which was developed by Redcar and Cleveland College, Thompsons of Prudhoe and the Teesworks Skills Academy. The course includes training on safe working practices, confined spaces, demolition, asbestos awareness and upon completion they gain a CCDO Demolition Labourer Card.

Phillip, 36 from Grangetown said 'I was really interested in the opportunities available on the Teesworks site and the Teesworks Skills Academy has helped me get back into full time employment, and I'm looking to carry on training.'

Darryl, 48, from Redcar was previously a steel fabricator and wanted to get back to work on the site. He said: 'The Teesworks Skills Academy has helped me get back into employment and I'm hoping to develop my skills further with Thompsons of Prudhoe and train on machinery.'

Helen Hillary, Group Company Director of Thompsons of Prudhoe said: 'As a company we were very excited to become a linked employer with Redcar & Cleveland College and the Teesworks Skills Academy to help provide training to local people leading to employment. The Routeway to Demolition Course is a fantastic opportunity to provide industry led training for the unemployed, which gains a recognised qualification as a Demolition Operative ready to start work. Everyone who attended the course was guaranteed an interview of which we successfully employed 3 candidates who are going from strength to strength.'
