With numbers like these, the scale of opportunities across the Teesworks site, and the impact the Academy is having, is clear to see.



INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY



The future of Teesworks is in their hands!

With only 25% of the STEM workforce currently female, it is vital we help girls with a passion for these areas realise their potential and secure opportunities across our region so they can stay local and go far.

With that in mind, we gave six young women from Middlesbrough College, all interested in STEM, an exclusive behind-the-scenes tour of the Teesworks site in recognition of International Women's Day.

The tour took in major demolition projects across the huge site including the Redcar Blast Furnace, Sinter Plant and BOS Plant before heading down to see the development under way at the £107million South Bank Quay and the earmarked SeAH site, set to produce the world's largest plant for producing wind turbine monopiles.

As part of the tour, the students met the Tees Valley's female business leaders as well as representatives from the Academy and the Education Training Collective, providing an opportunity to find out more about jobs and training opportunities.

Joely, one of the students joining the session said: "I didn't realise the number of opportunities on Teesworks – it's given me a lot to think about for my career."

Erika Marshall, Group Marketing Director of the Education Training Collective – Teesworks Skills Academy's delivery partner – said: "The opportunities for young people on our doorstep are immense, so many sectors are booming here including in the STEM arena, and there is a real need to open the eyes of our young people to those opportunities. I was never told about the possibilities of being an engineer or a construction manager or even of the roles which support those professions, so to be able to share some of my own experience to raise the aspirations of the young women who joined us for this tour is something I am really passionate about – how can our young people aspire to be a 'something' if they don't know that 'something' exists?"



CASE STUDY - LUCY



Teesworks Skills Academy opens up a new career path for Lucy.

Lucy, inspired by her father's profession and passion for the engineering industry, embarked on a Level 3 Generalised 2580 Engineering qualification to help fulfil her dreams of following in his footsteps.

After she completed her course with Redcar & Cleveland College, she was supported by the Academy to gain a work placement with Thompsons of Prudhoe and the 20-year-old has now gained full-time employment with the firm. Lucy said: "It's been incredible. I've had the chance to see things people never see in a lifetime [working on site] and even though I thought I knew what I wanted to do, my work has given me different opportunities.

"I've had some experiences in the past where I've been told that this is 'no environment for a woman' to work in, but here [Thompsons of

Prudhoe] it wasn't even an issue, I was just 'one of them', all together; and I'm really excited about this opportunity.

"I would absolutely encourage more people, and girls, to look at the Teesworks Skills Academy – it meant I could do my training and it has already led me to work, which is amazing."

Training Co-ordinator for Thompsons of Prudhoe, Sandra Lee, said: "Teesworks Skills Academy has been instrumental in helping us find, train and upskill local people – which is a big focus of the company."

Following the successful completion of her course in June, Lucy has been invited to take up a full-time role with the company.
